

2. The tender shall be deposited in electronic format on the e-portal www.jktenders.gov.in.
3. The Tenders uploaded on the website upto due date will be opened on 24-01-2017 or any other subsequent convenient date in the office of Directorate General, Fire and Emergency Services, J&K
4. The complete bidding process will be online.
5. Cost of tender documents of Rs. 2000/- in shape of demand draft (non-refundable) in favour of Accounts Officer, Fire & Emergency Services, J&K.
6. The tenders should be accompanied with Earnest Money of 50,000/- in shape of CDR pledged to Director General Fire & Emergency Services, J&K, Govt.
7. The tender shall remain valid for one year from the date of opening of bids.
8. The earnest money shall be forfeited if:
 - a) any tenderer withdraws his tender during the period of tender validity or makes any modification in terms and conditions of the tender.
 - b) the manufacture/Authorized distributor fail to execute the agreement within 45 days after supply order
9. Instruction to bidder regarding e-tendering process:- Bidders are advised to download bid submission manual from the Download option as well as from "Bidders Manual Kit" on website <http://jktenders.gov.in>. To participate in bidding process bidders have to get Digital Signature Certificate as per information Technology Act 2000. Bidders can get digital Certificate from approved vendor.

10. Bidders have to submit their bids online in electronic format with digital signature. No financial bid will be accepted in physical form.
11. Bids will be opened online as per time scheduled mentioned in para 3.
12. Bidders must upload the scanned copy of all necessary documents like CDR/PAN/TIN/Demand Draft (Tender Fee) /Registration certificate duly renewed and hard copies thereof physically to tender receiving Authority before date of opening bid.
Note: Scan all document on 100 dpi with black and white option
13. The department will not be responsible for delay in online submission due to any reason.
14. Cost of tender document in the shape of Demand draft and CDR (Earnest money/bid security) and relevant documents to be submitted to the Tender Receiving authority by registered post/courier/by hand before due date of submission of tender as per time scheduled specified.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF
e-NIT NO. 01 OF 2017 dated 04-01-2017.

(These terms and conditions are mandatory and should be read very carefully by the intending tenderers while furnishing their tenders).

1. The hard copy of tenders must be submitted in separate sealed covers as indicated below and be enveloped in one cover duly sealed and super-scribed in bold typed words "supply of various *Automotive Storage Batteries*"
2. The hard copy of the tender shall contain:-
 - a. C. D. R;
 - b. Demand draft.
 - c. Manufacturer/ Authorized Dealership certificate, if any;
 - d. Registration Certificates with Sales Tax department;
 - e. Registration certificate with Industries department for requisite trade/ items (for SSI Units);
 - f. Sales Tax certificates for the year 2015-2016;
 - g. Present Status certificate of SSI Unit from Industries deptt;
 - h. List of samples;
3. The tenders must be submitted in one separate sealed cover containing **Earnest Money and technical details** and be enveloped in one cover duly sealed and super-scribed in bold typed words "TENDER FOR AUTOMOTIVE STORAGE BATTERIES".
4. Sample should be packed in separate cover super-scribed with RED INK on the face of cover as Sample for: ".....".
5. One sample with only one rate from one tenderer will be accepted for any item tendered for.
6. The tenders shall be opened by the State Level Purchase Committee as per scheduled mentioned at para 3 or any other subsequent convenient date in presence of the tenderers or their authorized representatives who wish to be present. State Level Purchase Committee will reserve the right to accept or reject any tender without assigning reasons.
7. The rate tendered should be written both in words and figures F.O.R Central Stores, Fire & Emergency Services Headquarters, Batamaloo Srinagar/ Gandhi Nagar Jammu.
8. The tenderer shall quote the authorized brands with specific mention of warranty period and replacement and shall also enclose the requisite authorization with the tender document.
9. Tenders should be filled in clearly with one ink. No additions/Alterations/ over-writings or erasures should be made in the tender. Correction, if any, done should clearly be initialed/ signed. No Conditional tender will be accepted.

10. The authorized dealers quoting their rates on authorized dealership basis should append the latest authorization certificate of their Principal's with relevant documentary proof of their registration with Sales Tax/ Income Tax department. Similarly the SSI Unit holders quoting their rates should furnish their latest registration certificates for the items tendered for duly signed by the authorized signatory of the Sales tax/ Income Tax department, should be appended with the tender.
11. The tender must be accompanied by the earnest money equivalent Rs. 50,000/- in the form of CDR/FDR from a recognized Bank. No cash/ cheque or demand draft/postal order shall be considered. The earnest money in the case of unsuccessful tenderer shall be refunded after final decision/acceptance of the contract, within one month whereas in the case of successful tenderers, it will be treated as the part of security deposit and will be released only after successful completion of the contract. The earnest money shall be pledged to the Director General, Fire & Emergency Services, J&K Jammu.
12. The rates should be quoted inclusive of all taxes, levies and duties etc. (including entry tax wherever applicable) and all charges F. O. R Central Stores Fire & Emergency Services, Gandhi Nagar Jammu/ Batmaloo, Srinagar Kashmir. Nothing extra will be paid over the quoted rates.
13. The tenderer while quoting rates shall quote one and definite rate for the particular item. In case more than one rate is quoted the same shall not be entertained and accounted for comparison of rates for such item.
14. The successful tenderers shall have to draw up an agreement within seven days from the date of issuance of the supply order for satisfactory completion of the contract. The charges on stamps etc. shall be paid by the supplier while executing the agreement.
15. Payment shall be made by the purchasing officer after the material is received, inspected and accepted and properly brought on stock registers of the department. No advance payment shall be made.
16. Remittance charges (Bank Commission) on payments made to the firm will be borne by the suppliers.
17. As soon as the acceptance of the tender is communicated to the successful tenderer the contract shall be binding on him. The formal deed incorporating the terms of the contract will be executed by the successful tenderer later on failure to execute such a bond/deed shall not however, prevent the contract from being enforced against him. Any loss sustained by the Government as a result of re-tendering the contract shall be recovered from the defaulter.
18. Any sum of money payable or due to the supplier including deposits returnable to him, shall be appropriated and set off against any claim of the Government/ purchase.
19. Goods shall be delivered in the Central Stores of Fire & Emergency Services, at Batmaloo Srinagar/ Gandhi Nagar Jammu duly packed in perfect condition. The supplier if he so desires may insure the goods against loss or theft, destruction, damages by natural calamity, loss by exposure to weather or otherwise viz war, etc. the insurance charges will have to be borne by the supplier and the department shall not be required to pay such charges, if incurred.
20. The successful tenderer who fails to supply the goods of the prescribed specification or fails to deliver the goods within the stipulated time as specifically mentioned in the supply order, the department shall be at liberty to arrange supplies by re-tendering or otherwise and the extra-

- cost which the department may incur in such process shall be made good from the defaulting agency. The period of delivery and validity can, however, be extended, if mutually agreed to within the currency of the contract, provided sufficient reasons/ justifications are given by the supplier in such individual cases.
21. The stores supplied should be in strict accordance with the approved sample and specification and as referred to in the tender document. The material not conforming to the requirement of the department shall be rejected and no payment shall be made for such supplies.
 22. Make and quality of each item shall specifically be mentioned against each item.
 23. The items which are covered under warranty/ shelf life shall be deemed to be governed by the respective warranty period/ shelf life and the supplying agency of such item shall be responsible for free maintenance of the item within the warranty period/ shelf life.
 24. The quantities indicated in the NIT as per the annexure are tentative and can be increased/ decreased without any prior notification.
 25. The contract/ supply order can be repudiated at any time if the supplies are not made according to satisfaction of the department
 26. All legal proceedings if necessity arise, to be instituted by either party (Govt. or Contractor), shall have to be lodged in the Courts situated in Jammu and Kashmir and not elsewhere.
 27. The tenderer should sign the tender at each page and at the end in token of the acceptance of all the terms, options and conditions of the tender.
 28. The rate accepted will remain in force for a period of one year from the date of placement of supply order.
 29. Tenders should be accompanied invariably by registered Sales Tax clearance certificate from the concerned Sales Tax Authorities. No tender without this certificate shall be entertained.
 30. Rate offered by the successful tenderers and acceptance of which is communicated to them, will under no circumstances be enhanced at any stage during the period of the contract.
 31. Rates offered once in the tender shall be treated as final and irrevocable and any later addition and intimation will not be entertained.
 32. The tenders shall be submitted only on the prescribed tender form.
 33. The suppliers/ successful tenderers shall be responsible for the proper packing of the supplies so as to avoid damage under normal conditions of transport by Rail, Road or Air and delivery of the material in good condition to the consignee at the destination. In the event of any loss, damage, breakage, leakage or any shortage, the tenderers shall be liable to make good the loss/shortage found at the time of checking, inspection of material by the consignee. No extra cost on such account shall be admissible.
 34. The SLPC reserves the right to accept or reject any tender without assigning any reasons therefore and dispense with any condition of the NIT.
