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Subject: - Minutes of the meeting of state Level Purchas Committee of Fire & Emergency Services J&K held on 28-06-2019 at Directorate of Fire & Emergency Services J&K Batamaloo Srinagar.

A meeting of the State Level Purchase Committee of Fire & Emergency Services, J&K, Batamaloo Srinagar was held on 28-06-2019 at 1100 hours at Directorate of Fire and Emergency Services, J&K, Headquarters Batamaloo, Srinagar.



After due deliberations held in continuation of discussion during the meeting held on 28-06-2019 in the Directorate of Fire & Emergency Services, J&K, Batamaloo Srinagar on the agenda points, the following decisions were taken in the meeting:-

Item No. 1:- Spare parts for Ashok Leyland / TATA (Fire Appliances) /Quick Response Vehicles and Portable Fire Pumps (RMP/ Portable)

In order to meet the urgent requirement of Spare parts for maintenance of Fire Tenders Fabricated on Ashok Leyland / TATA (Fire Appliances) and Fire Pumps (RMP/ Portable) the SLPC may consider the issue to procure the above items from Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) or their authorized dealers.



The issue was discussed threadbare and State Level Purchase Committee (SLPC) unanimously approved the purchase of Spare parts for Ashok Leyland / TATA (Fire Appliances) /Quick Response Vehicles and Portable Fire Pumps (RMP/ Portable) mentioned in the agenda as per Government e-marketing (GeM) portal & procedure or Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) or through their authorized dealers as per the manufacturer's price list applicable to the government departments.

Item No. 2:- Purchase of Fire Fighting Appliances /Equipments

To meet the requirement of the Fire Fighting Appliances / Equipments the SLPC may consider the issue to procure the above items on the current Government e-Market (GEM) rates or from the authorized dealers on manufacturer's price list applicable to the all government departments.

The issue was discussed threadbare and State Level Purchase Committee (SLPC) unanimously approved that the purchase of Fire fighting Appliance / Equipments be procured through Government e-Market (GEM) and in case of its non availability on Government e-Market (GEM) the same be procured through State Motor Garages, J&K however the fabrication on the chassis be made through e-Tendering as required /specified by the departmental technical committee.

Item No. 3:-Purchase of Disaster Management Equipments

The SLPC may consider the issue to procure the Disaster Management items from Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) or their authorized dealer on special rates applicable to the government departments as per the principal's price list. The items which are available on GeM Portal can be procured after following GeM procedure.

- I. The items for which the rates are approved by other state government departments or are in the process of approval of rates through tendering process during 2019-20 are proposed to be procured as per approved rates, by this department as well.
- II. The high tech imported items for which the rates have been approved by the department through tendering process and are still valid for procurement are also proposed to be procured as per approved rates.

The issue was discussed threadbare and SLPC unanimously approved the purchase of Disaster Management Equipments be made through e-Tendering, however in case of inadequate competition / poor response in the e-tendering adopt the rates approved by other government department or rates valid for the current financial year 2019-20 as per the relevant clause in the eNIT published in 2018-19 besides the item available on Government e-Market (GEM) be procured as per GeM portal and procedure.



Item No. 4:-Purchase of Uniform items:

- I. Textile Items:
- II. Rubber items (Duck-Back-India)
- III. Stitching Material

- I. During the last financial year the e NIT was issued for purchase of textile uniform items. Although requisite tenders were received for the item, however, the SLPC decided to follow the standing government instructions conveyed vide Circular No. FD/BPF/15/2012 dated 08-08-2012 by the Finance Department, which approved the purchase of textile items from J&K Handloom Development Corporation, Jammu/ Srinagar, on the rates / price fixed by the High Power Committee headed by the Commissioner Secretary to Government Finance Department and SLPC in its decision Dated: 08.05.2015 approved the purchase of all textile uniform items from the Jammu and Kashmir, Handloom Development Corporation, Jammu.
- II. Similarly during the year 2017-18 the SLPC F&ES in its meeting held on 13.12.2017 after threadbare discussion eventually approved the procurement of Rubber Gum Boots, PT shoes and Rain coats from Duck-back-India on special price applicable to government departments.

The issue was discussed threadbare and SLPC unanimously approved the purchase uniform items be made through e-tendering as per the specifications and after receiving samples from the tenderers and its approval by the department technical committee against proper examination and evaluation. However Rubber Gum Boots, PT shoes, Parka and Rain Coats be procured directly from the company on principals price list applicable to all government departments subject to the fulfillment of all codal formalities.

Item No. 5:- Purchase of Lubricants.

To meet the day to day requirement of lubricants the SLPC may consider their purchase from the authorized dealers on the Company price list applicable to government departments

The issue was discussed threadbare and SLPC unanimously approved the purchase of lubricants mentioned in the agenda be made through e-tendering, however in case of inadequate competition / poor response in the e-tendering obtain rates from the State Motor Garages, J&K for procurement.

Item No. 6:- Purchase of Delivery Fire Hoses Couplings and Suction Hoses

There is urgent requirement of various sizes of fire delivery hose in the department for smooth firefighting operations. For purchase of Fire delivery Hose the SLPC may consider and approve the procurement of various sizes of Fire Delivery Hoses Couplings and Suction Hoses through Government e marketing (GEM) rates from GeM Portal.

The issue was discussed threadbare and SLPC unanimously approved the purchase of Delivery Fire Hoses, Couplings & Suction Hoses mentioned in the agenda as per Government e-marketing (GeM) portal & procedure and in case of its non availability on Government e-Market (GEM) the same be procured through e-tendering.

Item No. 7:- Purchase of Office furniture through SSI unit

- i. To meet the requirement of Furniture items the SLPC may consider the purchase from SICOP.
- ii. To procure the required furniture through vide publicity / e-tendering.

The issue was discussed threadbare and SLPC unanimously approved the purchase of every kind of furniture be made through e-tendering.

Item No. 8:- Purchase of Hard Coke / Rejection Wood

To meet the requirement of Hard coke/ Rejection wood items the SLPC may consider the purchase through NIT.

The issue was discussed threadbare and SLPC unanimously approved the purchase hard coke / rejection wood be made through e-tendering.

Item No. 9:- Purchase of Painting Material

For maintenance of Fire Tenders / Staff vehicles and Portable Fire Pumps in the Regional Workshop Srinagar / Jammu, for which requirement of painting material is necessary to purchase from company rates / e-tendering.

The issue was discussed threadbare and SLPC unanimously approved the purchase painting material be made through e-tendering.

Item No. 10:- Updation of department Website

The department has also requirement of website updation and in this regard quotation has been received and the matter is placed before the committee for further course of action.

The issue was discussed threadbare and SLPC unanimously approved the updation of the departmental website be made within the financial competence of the department after fulfillment of codal formalities.

Item No. 11:- Repairs / Renovation of Hqrs / office building Srinagar

Urgency has been felt for repairs / renovation of Headquarters/ Office Complex of F&ES Hqr's at Batamaloo because of its shabby look. Since the initiating of tenders shall take considerable time. The SLPC may consider for urgent repairs through quotations as the building is located in the heart of Srinagar City and attracts attention of high profile dignitaries. The building is in extremely dilapidated condition and has not been restored / repaired since last two decades.

The issue was discussed threadbare and the SLPC unanimously approved the repairs and renovation of headquarters / office complex.

Item No. 12:- Purchase of Utensils

The departmental canteen has immense shortage of Kitchen items and needs to be purchased on urgent basis through local market after following codal formalities, within the financial competence of this Headquarter.

The issue was discussed threadbare and the SLPC unanimously approved the purchase of utensils for use in the Langer of Jawans may be procured as per minimum requirement from the local market after fulfillment of all codal formalities.

Item No. 13:- Purchase of Heavy duty Scanners

To meet the urgent requirement of Heavy duty Scanners the SLPC may consider the purchase of the item on the rates approved by the Director Stationery and Printing J&K or on Government e marketing (GEM) rates.

The issue was discussed threadbare and SLPC unanimously approved the purchase of heavy duty scanners mentioned in the agenda as per Government e-marketing (GeM) portal & procedure.

Item No. 14:- Purchase of Electric/ Sanitary Items / Water Purifier


The short term quotations have been floated vide this office order No. DF&ES/Acctt/2019/5158 dated 20.05.2019 published in local dailies for procurement. In this regard 05 hard copies have been received against the short term quotation and submit before the State Level Purchase Committee for post facto approval.

The issue was discussed threadbare and SLPC unanimously decided the item is pity and procurement is within the financial competence of the department after fulfillment of codal formalities.

Item No.15:- E-NIT No. 12 of 2019 dated 15.01.2019 for supply of Inflatable Floating Path / Rescue Walkway

The tender was floated for procurement of Inflatable Floating Path / Rescue Walkway 05 hard copies have been received against this NIT and are to be opened by the State Level Purchase Committee.


The Fire & Emergency Services, J&K invited e-tender which was hosted on e-portal in State website www.jktenders.gov.in and got published through Information Department in Local / National dailies and received 05 (five) hard copies against the e-NIT up to the due date and accordingly were opened by the State Level Purchase Committee and it was unanimously decided to get these offers technically evaluated through a subcommittee of departmental senior officers to be nominated by the Director General, Fire & Emergency Services, J&K.





Item No. 16:- E-NIT No. 1 of 2019 dated 19.01.2019 for supply of Commando Motor Bike along with Fire Entry suits

The tender was floated for procurement of Commando Motor Bikes along with Fire Entry suit on 19.01.2019. But till date only one hard copy has been received in response against the NIT No. 01 of 2019.


The SLPC after threadbare discussion and in view of inadequate competition / poor response unanimously decided to go for retender.
